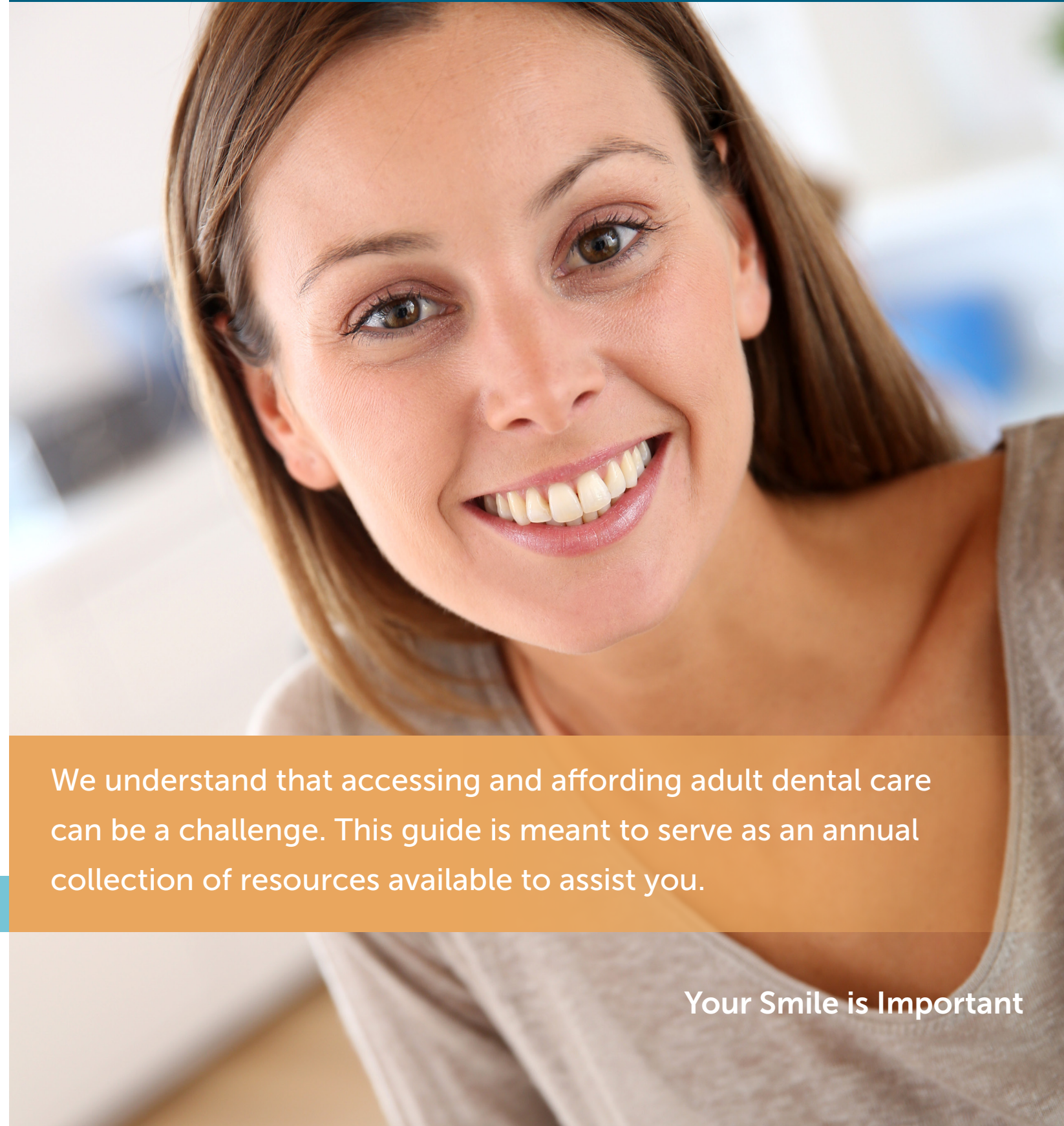

## New Hampshire Medicaid

**Efforts to provide comprehensive adult dental care through Medicaid in New Hampshire have not been successful to date.** For now, the only Medicaid plan that offers adult dental in New Hampshire is AmeriHealth Caritas NH. **Other Medicaid plans offer limited benefits that can help with dental care:**

### **NH Healthy Families - My Health Pays Rewards Program**

Adults and children can earn up to \$250 a year for healthy behaviors, which can be used to pay for dental care. You can also request a self-care dental kit.

### **Well Sense Health Plan**

Dental kits are available once a year upon request for \$2.

## LRCO Dental Grants

LRCO has a limited amount of funding available to help LRCO residents pay for uncovered dental services. This is a cost-share program and the amount of funding is determined on a case-by-case basis.
